Then the nurse said, “Have you heard the good news?” I said “No, what good news?” she said “We’re going to try to remove the tubes today.” Lord God, My faithful God! It soon hit me. I recalled that quiet short prayer that I made when I first entered the room. We witnessed them removing the tube and then her transition to eating light foods. What a glorious day. We focused on FAITH! The essential element for sustained empowerment and success.

The road ahead wasn’t easy but we got through. Our daughter made it through and her Faith was strengthened. She’s a trooper and mighty woman of God herself. Even at the rewrite of this we are believing God for breakthrough for our daughter. We were told many times that she will die and were even told any day, but God!

We must focus on Faith! We must hold fast to our confession of Faith. We will believe the report of the Lord until the very end.

As my Dad always said “Do all you can and trust God for the rest.” Thank you Daddy.

I thank God and once again our parents for the spirit of Faith that was instilled in us.
